  - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
  - 4 This Act may be cited as the "VA Clinical Training

3	SEC. 2. STANDARDS AND REQUIREMENTS FOR NON-DE-
4	PARTMENT MENTAL HEALTH CARE PRO-
5	VIDERS PARTICIPATING IN DEPARTMENT OF
6	VETERANS AFFAIRS COMMUNITY CARE PRO-
7	GRAM.
8	(a) In General.—The Secretary of Veterans Affairs
9	shall establish standards and requirements for the provi-
10	sion of mental health care by non-Department of Veterans
11	Affairs health care providers under the Community Care
12	program of the Department under section 1703 of title
13	38, United States Code. Such standards shall be the same
14	as the standards and requirements applicable to Depart-
15	ment employees who provide such mental health care.
16	(b) Training Requirement.—Not later than the
17	date that is 180 days after the date on which a provider
18	of mental health care becomes an approved provider under
19	the Community Care program of the Department under
20	section 1703 of title 38, United States Code, the Secretary
21	shall require the provider to complete—
22	(1) the basic course described in subsection
23	(c)(1); and
24	(2) each of the four clinical domain courses de-
25	scribed in subsection $(c)(2)$ .

1	(c) Courses Described.—
2	(1) Basic course.—The course described in
3	this paragraph is—
4	(A) a free, four-module course, made avail-
5	able online, that is developed by the Depart-
6	ment of Veterans Affairs about military culture
7	and core competencies for health care profes-
8	sionals; or
9	(B) a successor course or other course the
10	Secretary determines is comparable to the
11	course described in subparagraph (A).
12	(2) CLINICAL DOMAIN COURSES.—The courses
13	described in this paragraph are free courses, made
14	available online, in each of the following clinical do-
15	mains:
16	(A) Evaluation and management of sui-
17	cide.
18	(B) Post-traumatic stress disorder.
19	(C) Traumatic brain injury.
20	(D) Military sexual trauma.
21	(3) CONTINUING EDUCATION.—Each course de-
22	scribed in this subsection shall be designed to meet
23	continuing education requirements for mental health
24	care providers.
25	(d) Additional Training.—

1	(1) Identification of training areas.—Not
2	later than two years after the date of the enactment
3	of this Act, the Secretary shall identify at least three
4	clinical domains for which the need for care among
5	veterans is high and shall develop training courses in
6	those clinical domains.
7	(2) REQUIREMENT.—Not later than 60 days
8	after the training courses developed pursuant to
9	paragraph (1) are made available, the Secretary
10	shall require all non-Department mental health care
11	providers approved under the Community Care pro-
12	gram of the Department under section 1703 of title
13	38, United States Code, to complete the courses.
14	(e) Annual Report.—The Secretary shall submit to
15	the Committees on Veterans' Affairs of the Senate and
16	House of Representatives an annual report on the require-
17	ments of this section. Each such report shall include, for
18	the year covered by the report, the number of non-Depart-
19	ment mental health care providers who have completed the
20	requirements under this section
